John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

1. WHY Are We Sinners? – We Are Accountable to a Holy God

Isaiah 6:1-5 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His [robe] filled the temple. ² Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³ And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy [is] the LORD of hosts; The whole earth [is] full of His glory!" ⁴ And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke. ⁵ So I said: "Woe [is] me, for I am undone! Because I [am] a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts."

1 John 1:5 This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.

Rom 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness

a. Refusing to _____

Rom 1:20-21 For since the creation of the world His invisible [attributes] are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, [even] His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, ²¹ because, although they knew God, they did not glorify [Him] as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Rom 3:22b-23 For there is no difference; for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

James 4:17 Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do [it], to him it is sin.

James 2:10 For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one [point], he is guilty of all.

1 John 3:4 Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.

Rom 5:12-19 Therefore, just as **through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned**—¹³ (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law. ¹⁴ Nevertheless **death reigned from Adam to Moses**, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come. ¹⁵ But the free gift [is] not like the offense. For if **by the one man's offense many died**, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many. ¹⁶ And the gift is not like [that which came] through the one who sinned. For the judgment [which came] from one [offense resulted] in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. ¹⁷ For **if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one**, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.) ¹⁸ Therefore, **as through one man's offense [judgment came] to all men**, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act [the free gift came] to all men, resulting in justification of life. ¹⁹ For **as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners**, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.
