Rom 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
1 Cor 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin [to be] sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.
1 Pet 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit

## CHRIST DIED FOR US: WHAT DID HIS DEATH ACCOMPLISH?

## 1. Concerning

$\qquad$ Death: Perfect, immortal bodies like His Rom 7:24-25a $O$ wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? ${ }^{25}$ I thank God--through Jesus Christ our Lord!

1 Cor 15:49-53 ${ }^{50}$ Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God... ${ }^{51}$ Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed- 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet.
Phil 3:20-21 For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, ${ }^{21}$ who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body...
1 Jn 3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.
2. Concerning $\qquad$ Death:
a. His death provided eternal-quality to us

Jn 5:24 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.
Jn 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.
Jn 17:3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
b. His death transmitted His righteousness to our account

Rom 1:16-17 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. ${ }^{17}$ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." (Rom 3:19-28; 2 Cor 5:21)
c. His death enabled us to have a relationship with God

John 17:3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
Rom 5:1-2 ${ }^{1}$ Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ${ }^{2}$ through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
Eph 1:6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made us accepted in the Beloved.
3. Concerning $\qquad$ Death:
a. His death paid the eternal death penalty for our sins 1 Cor 15:3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,
1 Pet 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness...
b. His death secured for us never-ending life in His presence

1 Thes 4:17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
