**Participation: What Does It Take to Be Saved?  
What Must One Believe to Be Saved?**

**1. Salvation Requires Belief in a S \_\_\_\_\_ P \_\_\_\_\_**

**Acts 13:38-39** Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you **the forgiveness of sins**; <sup>39</sup> and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.

**Acts 17:26-31** ... <sup>30</sup> Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent, <sup>31</sup> because He has appointed a day on which **He will judge the world in righteousness** by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."

**Romans 1:18-21** For the **wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men**, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, <sup>19</sup> because what may be known of God is manifest in them, for God has shown [it] to them. <sup>20</sup> For since the creation of the world His invisible [attributes] are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, [even] His eternal power and Godhead, so that **they are without excuse**, <sup>21</sup> because, although they knew God, they did not glorify [Him] as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

**Romans 3:9-19** What then? Are we better [than they]? Not at all. For we have previously charged both Jews and Greeks that **they are all under sin**. <sup>10</sup> As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one; <sup>11</sup> There is none who understands; There is none who seeks after God. ... <sup>18</sup> "There is no fear of God before their eyes." <sup>19</sup> Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, **that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.** (cf. 1 Tim 1:8-11)

**John 3:36** "He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but **the wrath of God abides on him.**" (cf. John 3:18)

**2. Salvation Requires Belief in a S \_\_\_\_\_ P \_\_\_\_\_**

**a. Jesus Is the \_\_\_\_\_ Means to God**

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son...

**John 14:6** Jesus said to him [Thomas], 'I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to me Father except through me.'

**Acts 13:38-39**

**1 Tim 2:5-6** For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

**b. Jesus Was/Is \_\_\_\_\_ in the Flesh**

**Matt 1:(18)-23** "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

**John 1:1-3** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

**John 17:5** And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

**Rev 19:11-16** Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. <sup>13</sup> He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. <sup>16</sup> And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

**3. Salvation Requires Belief in a S \_\_\_\_\_ P \_\_\_\_\_  
and Resurrection**

**1 Cor 15:1-4** Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, <sup>2</sup> by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you--unless you believed in vain. <sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,

**1 Thes 4:14** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again...

**Rom 4:13-25** <sup>19</sup> And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. <sup>20</sup> He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, <sup>21</sup> and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. <sup>22</sup> And therefore "it was accounted to him for righteousness." <sup>23</sup> Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, <sup>24</sup> but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead, <sup>25</sup> who was delivered up because of our offenses, and was raised because of our justification.
