## **Communion Truths and Commitments**

This is a brief overview of how believers are to be reminded and respond to the communion service.

Communion Truths: The BREAD		
1.	Jesus His Body for Us:  1 Cor 11:23b-24the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; <sup>24</sup> and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body [which is broken] for you; do this in remembrance of Me."  Matt 20:28 "just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."  Heb 10:10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.  1 Pet 3:18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit	
2.	We Are of Jesus' Body: 1 Cor 10:17 For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread.  1 Cor 12:12-13 For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also <i>is</i> Christ. <sup>13</sup> For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.  Rom 12:5 so we, <i>being</i> many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.	
3.	We Are tofor Jesus' Body:  1 Cor 12:24b-26 But God composed the body, having given greater honor to that part which lacks it, <sup>25</sup> that there should be no schism in the body, but <i>that</i> the members should have the same care for one another. <sup>26</sup> And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with <i>it</i> ; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with <i>it</i> .  Eph 4:16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share.

Communion Truths: The CUP

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l.	Jesus the New Covenant by His Blood 1 Cor 11:25-26 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, ir remembrance of Me."	
2.	Jesus Secured Through This New Covenant Matt 26:28 "For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins."  Rom 5:9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.  Eph. 1:7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness or sins, according to the riches of His grace  Rev 1:5	
3.	Jesus Provides of the New Covenant to Use Heb 9:15 And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.  Titus 2:11-14 For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men 12 teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, 13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, 14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself <i>His</i> own special people, zealous for good works.	
1.	Jesus Reveals Our of the New Covenant Rom 6:5-11 Heb 10:19-25 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the	

Heb 10:19-25 **Therefore**, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup> by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, <sup>21</sup> and having a High Priest over the house of God, <sup>22</sup> **let us draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. <sup>23</sup> **Let us hold fast** the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup> And **let us consider one another** in order to stir up love and good works, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.
