## **Suggested Revision:**

We believe God created the heavens and the earth in six, literal, twenty-four-hour days, as recorded in Genesis; that this account is neither allegory nor myth, but a literal, historical account of the direct, immediate creative acts of God without any evolutionary process; that man was created by a direct work of God and not from previously existing forms of life; and that all men are descended from the historical Adam and Eve, first parents of the entire human race (Genesis 1; 2; Colossians 1:16, 17; John 1:3).
