# Measuring My Maturity, Part 1 (1 John 2:3-6): OBEDIENCE

Change of direction in topic, from present walking in the light to measuring our maturity – our spiritual growth/progress. How do I know how I am doing spiritually? Is there a way to KNOW? As we continue studying 1 John, we will look at three ways to measure our own majority. This week, we will look at the first measurement. How do I know when I have grown up spiritually?

# Measuring My Maturity: By Keeping God's Commandments

# 1. How Can I Know? The Measurement: Am I Keeping God's Commandments?

<sup>3</sup> Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.

- In this we are knowing (~) that we have come to know ( $\rightarrow$ ) Him, if we would be keeping (~) His commandments.
- a. We can PRESENTLY know ("by this we are knowing...")
- b. We can develop a close relationship to God OVER TIME ("we have come to know Him")
- c. Our clear measurement is ONGOING obedience to God's commands ("if we are keeping His commandments")
  - 1) Keeping...

## 2) Commandments?

*Mt* 28:20a "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you" John 15:14 "You are My friends if you do whatever I command you."

John 15:17 "These things I command you, that you love one another."

Acts 1:2 until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen,

Acts 13:47 "For so the Lord has commanded us: 'I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, That you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth."

## 877 NT Imperatives (Commands): Aorist (549x) + Present (328x)

# 2. How Can I Know? What the Measurement Is NOT: What I Am Saying (or Thinking)...

<sup>4</sup> He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

He who is saying that "I have come to know Him  $(\rightarrow)$ " while not keeping His commandments a liar is being (~), and in this the truth he is not being (~).

- a. The CLAIM: "I have come to know Him"
- b. The CRITERIA: Is not keeping His commandments...

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### c. The REALITY:

- 1) Is being a liar
  - Verb: 1:6 ("is lying")
  - Noun: 2:21,27 ("a lie")
  - Noun: 1:10; 2:4; 2:22; 4:20; 5:10 ("liar")
- 2) Is not being in the truth
  - Noun: 1:6; 1:8; 2:4; 2:21 2; 3:18; 3:19; 4:6: 5:6 ("truth")

# 3. How Does This Growing Process Work?

<sup>5</sup> But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

- But whoever would be keeping (~s) His word, truly in this the love of God has been completed ( $\rightarrow$ p); in this we are knowing (~) that in him we are being (~).
- a. [KNOWING the light / Word]

# b. KEEPING His Word (see 1 John 1:6-10)

- 1) Walking responsively to the light (truth), responding to what God says is true and what is right, heading the right way and countering our sinfulness, cleansing me from all sinfulness.
- 2) Saying the same thing God says about our sins as God reveals them to us, and God forgives us and cleanses us from all unrighteousness.
- c. RESULT: The love of God has been perfected in me.
- d. RESULT: I know that I am [walking] in God.

## 4. How to State Maturity a Different Way...

<sup>6</sup> He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

He who is saying (~) in him to be abiding (~) is being obligated (~), just and that one walked (x), also he himself thus to be walking (~).

- a. The CLAIM: He who SAYS he is abiding in Him (walking in the light; walking with God)
- b. The DEBT: Is presently OBLIGATED
- c. The MEASURE: Just as HE (Jesus) walked...
- d. The PRACTICE: To be WALKING

## TAKEAWAYS:

- We need to KNOW the light to walk by the light.
- As we walk in the light, we COME TO KNOW God.
- As we walk in the light, we KNOW God's commands.
- As we walk in the light, we KEEP God's commands.
- Our progress is measured by our obedience, not what we SAY we are doing or THINK we are doing.
