 - They were still living in the time when direct revelation was being given
 - They were still living in the time before the Scriptures were completed
 - This needs to be seen in light of these circumstances

4. Know the Core _____ of an Antichrist (22-23)

²² Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son. 23 Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.

- a. 22a Issue is specifically the identity of Jesus as Messiah
- b. 22b This issue ultimately denies both the Father and the Son
- c. 23a Denying the Son goes with denying the Father

- a. Command: Let what was revealed from the beginning be remaining (~!) in you
 - Requires knowing the truth
 - Requires living by the truth
 - Requires not drifting from the truth (false teaching; fads; filler)
- b. Condition:
 - IF what was revealed in [the] beginning remains in you...
 - THEN you will be remaining
 - o In the Son
 - o In the Father

7. John Summarizes What He Is Saying (26)

- ²⁶ These things I have written to you concerning those who *try to* deceive you.
- a. His Writing: I have written to you
- b. His Reason: Concerning the ones leading you astray (false teachers)

8. A Guarantee of the of God's Revelation (27)

- ²⁷ But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
- a. You (pl) are having: Present anointing (at that time) is remaining in you
- b. You Are NOT Having: A need that someone might be teaching you (pl)
 - This cannot be saying that We need no teachers (the Bible is clear otherwise: Mt 28:20; Acts 20, etc.)
 - This has to be understood as what had been revealed before all Scripture had been completed. Orally transmitted truth by NT prophets and other revelatory gifts were to be held onto.
- c. What? The same anointing is teaching YOU concerning all [things]
- d. Why?
 - It is (~) true
 - It is (~) not a lie
- e. So?
 - Just as it has taught you
 - Be remaining (~!) in it
